Opportunity Overview

The Job

CUP and LTB jointly seeks a Media Production Assistant to produce program material for Life and Kaos Podcast, a podcast about social innovations and the social problems that thwart them, L.I.F.E. Lessons, a podcast that features talks about psycho-social limitations and manners of their removal to create desired life outcomes, and Pre-Pilot Social Media Shorts for Hallowed Harmony, a comedy drama about fictional activist festival junkies making their way in the current US socio-political climate. The two podcasts are highly produced interview-based and workshop-based programs, while the comedy shorts are staged "reality tv" productions.

Assistants help produce and edit video and audio with industry standard software and add other contributors to the programs including generating story and scene ideas, conducting research, assisting with and arranging interviews, writing press releases, program copy and developing other production materials, and supporting live events production. Designing digital content for social media outlets is an integral part of CUP's products, and employee will be expected to be creative in the generation and contribution of audio and digital material in coordinating efforts with the other members of the CUP and LTB Teams.

In this CUP & LTB join Internship Position, people will learn and work under a cooperative self-directed worker owned business.

Daily Duties

- General administrative support includes answering phones, managing calendars, handling travel, submitting expense reports; and maintaining and updating databases, resource grids and assignment charts.
- Additional responsibilities include managing social media delivery calendars, managing, coding and tracking social media posts, and maintaining company equipment and its transport status.

- Assist with the creation of comprehensive talent procedural documentation, itineraries, various best
 practices guide; transportation, hotel and other reservations, hair & makeup, and other details podcast
 productions as well as help with maintaining databases and necessary information to facilitative them.
- Onsite podcast production coverage, assisting with talent travel, ticket distribution, etc. While virtual events and appearances remain the norm, assistants would be expected to be "onsite" and available virtually for these as well.
- Edit audio and video from host interviews and archives
- Prepare scripts and other materials as required
- Assist hosts in content creation segment and interview material for host, producers, and studio guests
- Performs research and pitches ideas for interviews and segments
- Conducts research for interviews and segment development including pre-interviewing of guests and preparation of resulting material for hosts
- Writes program copy including press releases and drafts copy for promos
- Supports events production during live by collaborating with digital teams to provide technical support for
 events, facilitating audience engagement in real time with host and guests and ensuring audio of live
 events is properly recorded remotely and transferred
- Performs other duties as assigned
